At a Glance...Community Services

SERVICE	AGE	SERVICE DESCRIPTIONS
Home-Based	4-21	Provides a combination of mental health services tailored to the specific needs of children, teens, and families in crisis, including family relationship building; parent coaching, anger management, and communication skills training; daily living skills support; therapeutic mentoring; and crisis support. Individual and family counseling by licensed clinicians also available. Intensive In-Home provides mental health services for children ages 4-21 who are at-risk for out-of-home placement or who are returning to the community from an out-of-home placement and require support to be successful. Intensive In-Home provides 3-10 hours of service per week, including case management, medication management, and 24 hour emergency assistance.
Therapeutic Mentoring	4-21	Connects children and adolescents with an adult Therapeutic Mentor who serves as a positive role model providing support, coaching, training, and supervision in developing communication skills, problem-solving skills, interpersonal skills, social skills, age-appropriate behaviors, constructive use of leisure time, and resiliency skills.
Outpatient Therapy	6 & older	Provides therapy and counseling to children, adolescents and families who have mental, behavioral or emotional symptoms that impair daily life activities. Medicaid and other insurance plans accepted.
Therapeutic Day Treatment	4-21	Serves students through a combination of psychotherapeutic interventions, education, and mental health treatment in order to improve their level of functioning in the classroom and major life activities. Elk Hill Staff are present throughout the school day to provide classroom intervention, psychoeducational groups, individual and family counseling, medication education and management. Elk Hill employs highly qualified and diverse Qualified Mental Health Professionals (QMHPs) to provide Therapeutic Day Treatment, as well as Licensed Mental Health Professionals (LMHPs) to provide counseling services and supervision to all QMHPs.
